New Meeting Location for 2017

Hi 1960 PC Users Group Members,

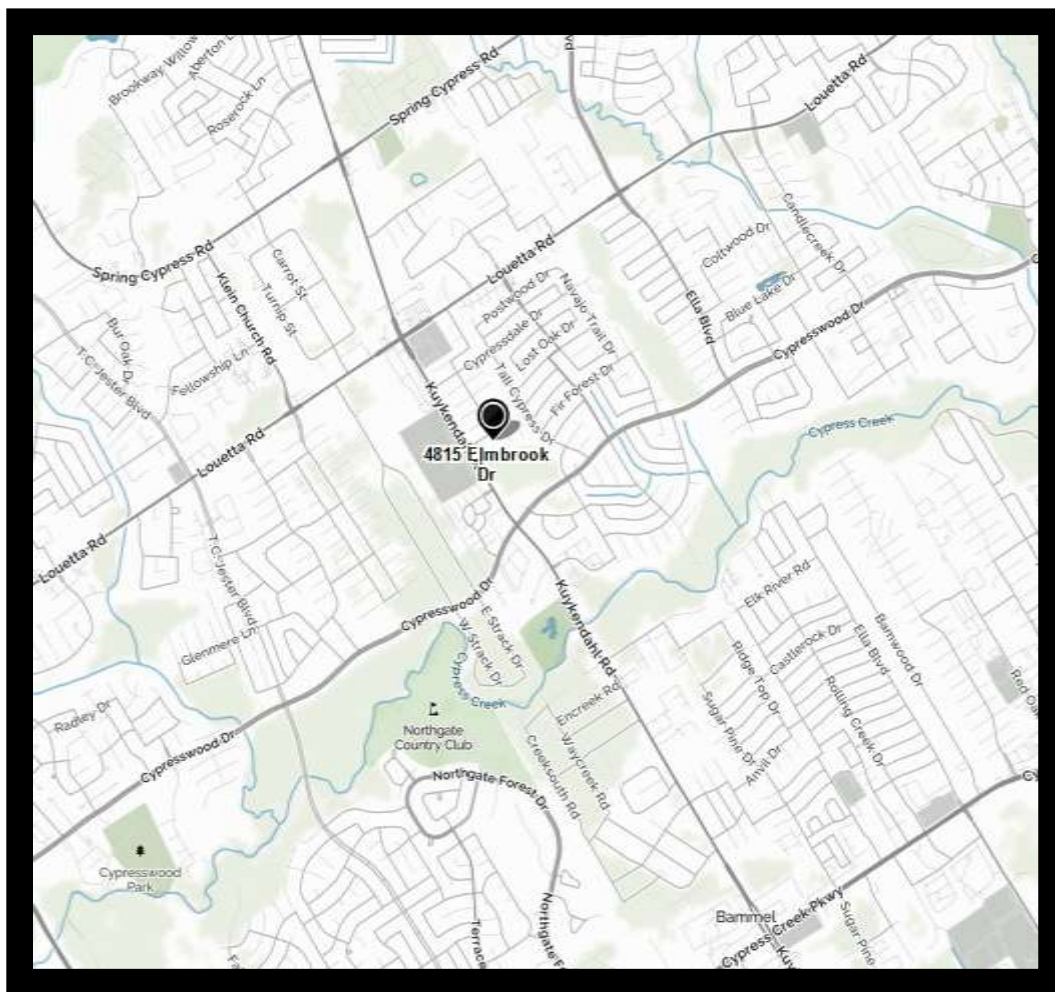
Starting in January 2017 the club will move to a new meeting location. The reason we are moving is that when CCCC doubled our meeting room rent we could no longer afford to stay there. The new fee is based on cost per session, not a flat fee. By moving to a new location, we have cut the monthly rental fee in half.

We will have three SIGs starting January 2017. The Digital Photography SIG will meet on the first Thursday of the month, the Technology SIG on the second Tuesday of the month and the Genealogy SIG on the fourth Thursday of the month. The Graphics SIG has been retired.

The new location has several advantages. The farthest walk to the meeting room is only 150 ft, there are no stairs to climb, we are the only group meeting there, and the sun will not be a problem in the summer months. The room size is approximately the same as the annex room 30 at CCCC. Meeting nights will not be changed because of other events conflicts at the location, and there won't be any disruption and noise from other groups.

Starting January 2017 club SIG will be meeting in the Cypressdale Club House, 4815 Elmbrook Dr. Spring TX., just a half block east of the intersection of Kuykendahl Rd. and Elmbrook Dr. It is 2.6 miles due east of CCCC. The subdivision does have constable coverage. You might want to drive to the club house during daylight hours sometime soon so you can find it easily in January.
